Gate card numbers not reported will be labeled lost and deleted from the card reader. Mail boxes and gate cards (\$6.00) are available from John Morris Lot # 174.

Enclosed is a self addressed stamped envelope for your use to 1) make your payment of fees due, 2) return the information requested, 3) mail in your absentee ballot or 4) mail in your proxy for someone else to vote for you.
