Recipe

Whipped Sweet Potato Bake

3 cans (15 oz. ea.) sweet potatoes, drained
1/3 cup (1/2 stick) of butter or margarine, melted
1 Tsp. ground cinnamon 1/2 Tsp. salt 1/4 Tsp. ground nutmeg
3 cups of Jet Puffed Miniature Marshmallows

Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees. Beat sweet potatoes, butter, cinnamon, salt, nutmeg in medium bowl with electric mixer on medium speed until well blended. Spoon into lightly greased 11/29" baking dish, top with marshmallows. Bake 15 to 20' or until sweet potato mixture is heated thoroughly and marshmallows are lightly browned.
