B'fast Casserole -

- 1 9" unbaked frozen pie crust
- 1 tbs. butter,
- 12 slices of bacon
- 4 eggs,
- 2 cups of 1/2 & 1/2
- 3/4 tsp. salt,
- 1/8 tsp. black pepper
- 1-1/2 cups grated Swiss Cheese

Pinch of nutmeg, sugar, cayenne

1 tsp dried minced onion

Rub butter on pie shell. Crumble cooked bacon over the bottom. Sprinkle w/cheese. Beat eggs, ½ & ½ milk & spices. Pour over cheese & bacon mixture. Bake @425 for 15" then reduce oven to 300 degrees for 40" or until knife comes out clean.

Mix/ spread on top of Souffle. Bake @ 350 degrees for 30".
