RECIPE OF THE MONTH: (Submitted by Val Cuce)

HUMMINGBIRD BREAD PUDDING

Total Time: 1 hr.35 min Cook Time: 45 min Yield: 8 servings

Preparation: Heat the oven to 350 F Butter or use nonstick cooking spray to grease 13" x 9" x 2.5" glass casserole dish.

INGREDIENTS:

- 6 large eggs
- 3 cups milk
- 1 cup sugar
- 3 tablespoons vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon

2 bananas, 1 mashed, 1 cut into small bites

1 can (20 oz.) crushed pineapple, drained very well

1 cup shredded coconut

1 cup chopped pecans

¹/₂ loaf French bread, (baguette type), cubed or torn into small pieces

DIRECTIONS:

Using a whisk or electric mixer, mix together eggs and milk, add in sugar, vanilla and cinnamon. Beat together until the sugar starts to dissolve. Mix in the mashed banana. Gold in the banana pieces, pineapple, coconut and pecans. Mix in the bread and let the mixture sit for 10 to 15 minutes, stirring after 5 to 10 minutes. Pour mixture into prepared pan and bake in preheated oven for about 45 minutes or until temperature in center is about 260 degrees.

CREAM CHEESE PECAN SAUCE:

- 4 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 3 tablespoons powdered sugar, plus extra if needed ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract
- ⁷4 teaspoon vanina extract
- 4 tablespoons milk, plus extra if needed
- 1 cup toasted crushed pecans, for sprinkling on top

Directions for Sauce:

Whip cream cheese with mixer then slowly add sugar until smooth. Add vanilla. Add milk as needed for proper consistency.

Let bread pudding cool slightly, and then drizzle Cream Cheese Sauce over warm pudding. Top with toasted pecans.
