#### 3-2-1 Cake

These individual little cakes are amazing and ready to eat in one minute. They are perfect for whenever you feel like a treat without all the fat and calories that cakes can have. Ingenious idea!

Ingredients: 1 box <u>Angel food cake mix</u> 1 box Cake Mix - any flavor

Directions: In a gallon Ziploc bag, combine the 2 cake mixes together and shake to blend well. For each individual cake serving, take out 3 Tablespoons of the cake mix combination and mix it with 2 Tablespoons of water in a small microwave-safe container (a coffee cup for instance). Microwave on high for 1 minute and you have your own instant individual little cake!

Keep remaining cake mixture stored in the Ziploc bag and use whenever you feel like having a treat. You can top each cake with a dollop of fat free whipped topping and/or some fresh fruit. The egg whites are in the angel food cake mix, so do not use if you are allergic to eggs. If you are diabetic or not using sugar, you can use a sugarless cake mix. Have fun!
