



FRIENDLY REMINDERS...

The speed limit within the park for ALL TYPES of transportation is 10 MPH – You will be asked to SLOW down if believed to be speeding (please don't be offended) we want to keep everyone safe!!





Ice Cold Drinks are available in the fridge in the Pavilion. It's the honor system so be sure to pay up! Soda's - .50 and Water - .50

Bags of ice are available in the breezeway at the pavilion. This is also on the honor system, and they are \$3.00/bag.





All pets (dogs, cats, ferrets, snakes, lizzards, etc...all pets) must be on a leash at all times

when on common property. Owners must pick up after their pets. Barking dogs must be controlled by their owners so as not to be a nuisance to neighbors. Due to Paradise Valley's insurance company regulations, the following canines will no longer be allowed in the campground by owners or renters: Staffordshire Terrier, American Terrier, Bull Terrier, Doberman Pinscher, German Shepherd. Rottweiler, or any combination thereof. In addition, any dog (regardless of breed or size) with bite history and/or any dog used for the purpose of quarding the premises will also be prohibited. No dogs shall be tied and/or left unattended outside on property. Please be sure to pick up after your pets!!

> No motorbikes, motorcycles, motor scooters, all-terrain vehicles or other vehicles of that type may be operated on the

properties except to be used for ingress and egress from public roads to the individual's lot. Exempts are such vehicles which are licensed and equipped with noise- restricting mufflers.

Please remember we have lots of wildlife within the park. We have beavers building



new things in the "big" creek and deer are always meandering around the park! It is also spring which means those beautiful black bears will be waking up soon! For the safety of our human families and our precious



wildlife please keep your garbage and bird feeders put away at night. Keep your cameras handy!
